*"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."* John 3:16

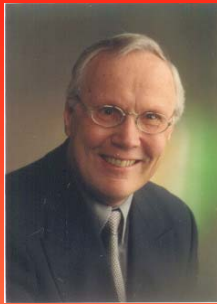
As Christians we are the objects of God's initiative through Jesus Christ to create for Himself a people who would vindicate His name among the nations.
